## ORIGINAL HYDRAULIC FLOORS FROM 1950

Hydraulic floors are undoubtedly beautiful. Their strength and charm are undeniable, as their mere presence provides any space with its own personality.

These pigmented cement tiles, used indoors and outdoors, were invented in France in the mid-19th century and were used as flooring in constructions up to the 1960s. They are made with hydraulic presses. In recent years, they have started coming back into fashion and are becoming more common.

At ART & SUITE APARTMENT CÁCERES, our hydraulic flooring is in an excellent state of conservation, considering it is from the year 1950.
